THE VET ADVICES...

WELCOME DEAR PET LOVERS! HERE YOU FIND USEFUL TIPS AND RULES TO HAVE A PLEASANT HOLIDAY IN JESOLO

REGULATION

- Legal obligations: microchip and feces collecting bags. If coming from abroad, the
 anti-rabies vaccine (made within three weeks before and currently valid) and the
 passport are necessary as well.
- **Social obligations of common sense:** Take the dog's updated health booklet with you
- 1. Have your dog undergo a medical check-up before the departure and be sure the regular vaccinations are still valid (distemper, infective hepatitis, parvovirus infection, leptospirosis...)
- 2. The anti-rabies vaccine is especially advised: legal consequences from the veterinary police can be incurred if a non-vaccinated dog bites a civilian, so be sure your dog is safe!
- 3. Carry out the prevention for the following diseases:
- 4. Ectoparasites (fleas, ticks...) through balms to smear between the shoulder blades of the dog or through oral tablets if frequent baths or showers are expected, at least 2-3 days before the departure
- 5. Endoparasites (intestinal parasites that can be transmitted to humans) through oral tablets which will be ordered by the vet, 5 to 2 days before the departure



MOREOVER


- Maintain the usual diet
- If you take your dog to the beach be sure that it does not eat a lot of sand or that it does not drink salt water to prevent gastro-intestinal complications (vomit, diarrhea...)
- Please avoid exposing your dog to high temperatures to prevent heatstroke and limit physical exercise during the central hours of the day
- Make your dog wear a collar with an ID tag and your phone number to prevent loss
- Special care needs go to brachycephalic breeds (bulldogs, pugs, boxers, shit-tzus, pekes...), dogs with heart diseases, old dogs and puppies

Contrary to the majority of the Mediterranean basin, our territory is free from *leishmaniosis*, a severe disease which can be transmitted by sandflies.

By the way, as in every other country where the temperatures reach the 23° C, even in Jesolo the *Heartworm disease* can represent a danger for your dog. In order to prevent it, it is sufficient to give it an oral tablet within one month from the first day of your stay (you can obtain it from our affiliated vets who provides us with support).

Beyond the designated areas, our four-legged friends are not allowed to walk along the beach or to stay under the umbrellas. There are three dog-friendly beaches in Jesolo: the first free access is in the West zone on the mouth of the river Sile (lighthouse zone). The second also free access is in the Est zone on the mouth of the river Piave (Cortellazzo zone). In both these areas your dog can move freely but he's not allowed to bathe. The third is a reserved payment beach, called Bau Bau Beach, with many dedicated services (access from Via Vittorio Veneto). In this area your dog can move freely and also bathe. Regarding public parks, dogs are allowed only on a leash. You must take with you also a muzzle and the means (e.g. a bag) to clean up your dog's feces.
